**Winters, California --**

This is in reference to earlier Press Releases by the The Winters Police Department into the disappearance of **LETICIA BARRALES RAMOS**, and the arrest of the suspect, **Felipe Cruz Hernandez**.

Ms Ramos is still missing and presumed dead. Winters Police Department received information that a site, located in an isolated area ½ mile west of the Railroad Avenue bridge, was reported as being suspicious. A visual inspection of the area revealed enough indicators, recently turned ground, to warrant the request for mutual aid resulting in the assistance of the canine cadaver dogs. The suspicious site was searched by two cadaver dog teams coordinated through the Office of Emergency Services. However, no remains were located at the site. The Solano County Sheriff's Department also assisted in the search.
