GENERAL ORDER #20-05 RESERVE OFFICERS – P.O.S.T. PERISHABLE SKILLS PROGRAM (PSP)

Date: July 27, 2020

I. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This General Order amends and supplements Winters Police Department Policy 349 “Reserve Officers.” This General Order does not take effect until the next California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) compliance cycle beginning January 1, 2021.

II. POLICY

In addition to the minimum training standards outlined in California Penal Code § 832.6(a) and P.O.S.T. Regulations 1005 and 1007 (California Code of Regulations § 1005 and §1007), and in order to maintain continued employment with the Winters Police Department, Reserve Officers are required to complete the POST Perishable Skills Program (PSP) training every compliance cycle. The Continuing Professional Training (CPT) credit earned by completing the PSP’s will go to satisfy the Reserve Officer’s minimum CPT requirement.
